




2024 SNAPSHOT: INTERNATIONAL ASSOCIATION MEETINGS AT A GLANCE

The 2024 ICCA meetings data highlights a continued recovery and upward trend in the association meetings sector.



In 2024, over 11,000 ICCA-eligible international association meetings were recorded across all regions. Europe continues to lead, followed by Asia-Pacific and North America, with Latin America, Africa, and the Middle East contributing significantly. Each region brings distinct strengths and sectoral expertise, reflecting a worldwide knowledge exchange ecosystem.

MOMENTUM ACROSS BORDERS

At the country level, the United States remains the top-ranked country, followed by Italy, Spain, Germany, and the United Kingdom. The top five destinations have remained consistent year over year, with one subtle shift: the United Kingdom has moved into the #5 position, just ahead of France.

Latin America and the Middle East continue to demonstrate rising influence as emerging regions. From 2022 to 2024, they were the only regions to show consistent year-over-year growth in the number of meetings recorded. Asia Pacific is becoming increasingly competitive, with 13 countries now ranked among the global top 50, just behind Europe. Meanwhile, there is growing government interest across Africa in strengthening infrastructure and capacity for international meetings, signalling potential for accelerated growth in the years ahead.

VIENNA AND LISBON RACE TO THE TOP, DUBAI LEADS IN A DIFFERENT WAY

City rankings show a similar blend of consistency and movement. Vienna claims the top spot globally in 2024, moving up from the #4 position the previous year. Lisbon ranks a very close #2, one meeting fewer, followed by Singapore, Barcelona, and Prague. Paris, which held the top position in 2023, now sits in the #6 position – still a notable achievement in a year when it also hosted the Summer Olympic Games.

Beyond total event counts, another view of city performance emerges from average attendance per meeting. Dubai leads this alternative ranking, with an average of 899 participants per event, followed by Barcelona, Milan, Bali, and Melbourne. This view highlights destinations that draw larger audiences, reinforcing the strategic value of hosting major international meetings.

GLOBAL SUBJECT SECTOR PRIORITIES

By subject matter, Medical Sciences, Technology, and Science lead the way, followed by Industry and Education. These five sectors have remained in the top positions for over a decade, underscoring sustained interest globally in healthcare innovation and digital transformation. Medical Sciences leads the field significantly, demonstrating the demand for collaboration in health and life sciences.

RETHINKING MEETING SIZE

While large, city-wide congresses still draw attention, ICCA's 2024 data confirm that most international association meetings are moderate-sized (150 – 999 participants), creating opportunities to foster deeper engagement. When strategically aligned with destination priorities, these meetings often deliver meaningful returns.

SUCCESS IN DIFFERENT WAYS


The ICCA Rankings are often read top-down, but that's not the only story they tell.

Beneath the numbers lies a more nuanced view of success. Whether it's economic contribution, long-term legacy impact, or specific sectoral leadership, this has become part of a positioning strategy for many countries and cities. It's how they speak to government stakeholders, attract investment and align academic institutions.

This deeper understanding reflects ICCA's mission to elevate the relevance and impact of international association meetings, positioning them as essential platforms for countries' advancement rather than merely tourism products.

THE ECONOMIC VALUE OF INTERNATIONAL ASSOCIATION MEETINGS CAN'T BE OVERLOOKED


In 2024, global travel and tourism generated an economic impact of approximately USD 10.9 trillion, accounting for about 10% of global GDP, supporting around 357 million jobs worldwide. According to ICCA's 2024 data, international association meetings contributed USD 11.6 billion in immediate economic impact, a specialised yet important segment within the global tourism sector.





A PATTERN OF GROWTH

Over the past decade, the average meeting delegate spend has increased by 24% since 2015. This is a clear sign of the growing value of hosting meetings.







THE ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT ENGINE: PROOF OF IMPACT FROM TOP DESTINATIONS

International association meetings are economic catalysts, and the 2024 ICCA data reinforce this. Cities and countries that actively attract these meetings generate tangible economic returns. From global capitals to emerging destinations, one thing is clear: these meetings matter.

VIENNA

Vienna hosted 154 international meetings and welcomed 101,886 delegates in 2024, helping sustain local economic activity in a city that accounts for 25% of Austria's GDP.

BARCELONA

Catalonia's GDP grew 3.6% in 2024, surpassing Spain (3.2%) and the EU (0.8%). Barcelona contributed to this growth by hosting 125,826 delegates at 142 international meetings.

SINGAPORE

Singapore's GDP grew 4.4% in 2024, with tourism and business events as key drivers. The 144 international meetings that welcomed 93,012 delegates played a significant role in this growth.

COPENHAGEN

Copenhagen's 101 highly targeted international meetings supported Denmark's 2.4% GDP growth in 2024, attracting 53,014 delegates and reflecting the city's focused approach to high-impact events.

What types of meetings should destinations prioritise attracting? ICCA encourages destinations to adopt impactdriven strategies, and its 2024 data reveals strategic opportunities across meeting sizes. The table below highlights how small, mid-sized, and large meetings differ in terms of volume, economic contribution, and fit for different destination profiles.

ICCA encourages destinations to think holistically about strategic meeting selection, measuring economic returns on internationalisation and city development. The 2024 data prove that:

- Destinations prioritising alignment over volume achieve higher returns per meeting.
- Well-selected meetings create sustainable growth beyond immediate tourism revenue.
- The economic contribution of international meetings rivals major sectors while requiring fewer resources.
- These findings reinforce the case for intentional, impact-driven meeting strategies.






Driving Impact Together

BEYOND ECONOMICS: THE ICEBERG MODEL OF INTERNATIONAL ASSOCIATION MEETINGS

Association meetings represent a powerful — but often underestimated force in today's interconnected — world. Like icebergs, their visible economic impact — hotel room nights, delegate spending, and venue revenue — is merely the tip. Beneath the surface lies far greater value that transforms nations and communities.





CATALYSING PROGRESS THROUGH SHARED PURPOSE

International association meetings are uniquely positioned to tackle today's most pressing challenges by:

- Creating platforms where diverse expertise and cross-regional perspectives converge.
- Generating collaborative solutions that no single organisation or country could achieve alone.
- Mobilising global action through shared goals and coordinated strategies.

IMPACT BEYOND NUMBERS

For our global community, the significance of these meetings extends far beyond immediate financial returns and attendee numbers.

While many ICCA-recorded meetings in 2024 welcomed fewer than 1,000 delegates, their impact remains outsized. The ISO/IEC 42 Artificial Intelligence Plenary Meeting held in Seoul, Republic of Korea, brought together approximately 200 delegates from over 40 nations to advance the development of crucial AI standards. Bogota, Colombia hosted the 2024 World Symposium on Transport and Land Use Research, with just shy of 200 people, but held important exchanges on the balance of connectivity and land use.

NOT BECAUSE OF HEADCOUNT

Forward-thinking destinations understand the Iceberg Principle. For destinations, association meetings offer strategic advantages that extend far beyond visitor economy metrics.



The cumulative effect is powerful. From youth engagement and sustainability to scientific breakthroughs and policy development, each meeting contributes to a broader advancement.

MORE MEETINGS = MORE IDEAS EXCHANGED MORE MEETINGS = MORE LIVELIHOOD CHALLENGES ADDRESSED

A standout example comes from the <u>European Academy of Childhood Disability (EACD)</u>, winner of the 2024 Incredible Impacts Award. Their 36th Annual Meeting not only advanced research and awareness around childhood-onset disabilities but also created real-world impact through the EACD+ programme, which expanded access to sport, culture, and technology for individuals with disabilities. It exemplified how even modestly sized association meetings can foster equity, inclusion, and lasting community legacy.

In the international association meetings sector, purpose doesn't follow success. It defines it.

MEETING SECTORS: STRATEGIC ALIGNMENT FOR DIFFERENT DESTINATIONS

At first glance, Medical Sciences, Science, and Technology continue to dominate the volume of international association meetings. A deeper view reveals emerging areas and how these sector meetings align with high-growth, highly dynamic industries.

ALIGNING SECTOR MEETINGS WITH FUTURE GROWTH ARENAS

Recent McKinsey research identifies 18 "arenas of tomorrow," predicting they will generate \$29 – 48 trillion in revenues by 2040, growing from 4% of global GDP to 10-16%. Destinations that align their meeting acquisition strategies with these future growth arenas will see significant advantages.

AUTOMATION

Automation is a hot topic in Al applications, robotics, system integration, and tech-enabled sustainability. According to ICCA data, Automation as a meeting subject has climbed from #9 in 2015 to #5 in 2024.

Automation plays a key role in the following industry sectors that potentially will see significant growth in the next two decades: Al Software and Services, Shared Autonomous Vehicles, Modular Constructions, and Robotics.

DESTINATION ADVANTAGE

The United States, Japan, and Italy were the top three countries in 2024 that hosted the most technology-related meetings. Vienna leads the city ranking, while Tokyo, Athens, Prague, Singapore, and Barcelona closely follow.

NEXT-GENERATION ENERGY

Basic science research forms the foundation of tomorrow's energy system. Roughly 20% of all international science meetings are focused on disciplines critical to this topic, including Physics, Chemistry, Geology, Scientific Computing, and Mineralogy.

These industry sectors that potentially will see significant growth in the next two decades will benefit from the basic science research: Space, Batteries, and Nuclear Fission Power Plants.

DESTINATION ADVANTAGE

Nord<mark>ic countries and Canada h</mark>ave several advantages in attracting sustainable energy meetings.

- Since 2023, all 5 largest Nordic countries surpassed the EU's 2030 renewable energy target, with renewables making up 44.4% to 79.5% of their energy consumption. Canada produces over 80% of its electricity from non-emitting sources, primarily hydro, and is rapidly expanding wind, solar, and battery storage.
- Both regions boast prominent energy research centres, like KTH Royal Institute of Technology in Sweden and Ontario Tech University in Canada.
- The Nordics are home to global renewable giants (Vestas, Ørsted), while Canada is a major exporter of clean electricity to the U.S.

BIOTECHNOLOGY AND OBESITY TREATMENTS

Medical science meetings increasingly focus on revolutionary biotech advances and precision treatments. To progress in these areas, destinations can prioritise meetings focusing on endocrinology, diabetes, genetics, and pharmacology.

Industrial and consumer biotech and drugs on obesity and related conditions are the two industry sectors that potentially will see significant growth in the next two decades.

DESTINATION ADVANTAGE

Spain has established itself as a leading global hub for Medical Sciences meetings, ranking first overall in 2024. Barcelona and Madrid both secured spots among the top 10 cities, reflecting Spain's €940 million in R&D investment in biotechnology infrastructure.

TELECOMMUNICATIONS AND WIRELESS

Telecommunications and Wireless have surged in the ICCA rankings since 2022, driven by rising mobility and digital infrastructure demand. Telecommunications serve as the connective tissue for several McKinsey-identified future arenas including Cloud Services, Autonomous Vehicles, and Cybersecurity.

DESTINATION ADVANTAGE

While Asian technology hubs like Tokyo, Singapore, and Seoul are positioned strongly to attract meetings in this subject sector, opportunities exist for European cities with 5G testbeds (Helsinki, Stockholm), North American innovation corridors (Toronto, Montreal, Boston), and Middle Eastern smart cities (Dubai, Abu Dhabi).

ARTS, LIBRARY AND LITERATURE

Arts, Library and Information, and Literature are among the top 5 subject sector meetings that recovered the fastest from COVID-19, an encouraging sign that knowledge stewardship and cultural exchange remain deeply valued.

DESTINATION ADVANTAGE

Beyond Mediterranean cultural centres, Athens, Buenos Aires—known as "the bookshop capital of the world"— Edinburgh, New York, and Paris all offer distinct appeal for hosting arts and literature meetings.

HOW ASSOCIATIONS ARE SHAPING THE FUTURE OF MEETINGS

As the international meetings landscape evolves, associations are reimagining the role their events play in building community, advancing missions, and delivering lasting impact. In this section, we hear directly from association leaders on how their meetings are changing, new approaches to destinations, and a growing emphasis on sustainability, inclusion, and innovation.



HOW IMPORTANT ARE YOUR MEETINGS TO YOUR MEMBERS AND THE ASSOCIATION OVERALL?

Meetings play an essential role. They enable peer-to-peer knowledge sharing, support upskilling, and help ensure qualified workforces across industries and professions around the world," said Michelle Mason, President and CEO of ASAE. "They also convene widespread communities, building connections, establishing key relationships, and fostering mentorship.

WHAT DO YOU LOOK FOR IN A DESTINATION OR HOST CITY BEYOND INFRASTRUCTURE?

While accessible venues, reliable transportation, and ample lodging are essential, what truly sets a destination apart is its ability to offer unique, immersive experiences that align with the mission and culture of the association. Collaborating with a destination to create those tailored, place-based moments—whether it's a meaningful community engagement activity, a one-of-a-kind offsite venue, or an authentic local experience—can transform a meeting from simply successful to genuinely unforgettable.

Layered on those considerations are risk mitigation factors. According to the 2023 Association Guide to Risk and Crisis Management, published by ASAE and developed by ASAE, RIMS Risk Management Society, and ASIS International, crime and safety, destination weather/climate predictions, and health and safety measures are the top factors considered when selecting event destinations.

HOW DOES YOUR ASSOCIATION DEFINE SUCCESS BEYOND ATTENDANCE?

While every association has its own unique mission and audience, the most successful meetings tend to share several core elements: delivering clear member value, fostering a sense of community, offering high-quality educational programming that supports upskilling and peer-to-peer knowledge exchange, and creating meaningful opportunities for networking and engagement. Increasingly, associations are also prioritising the attendee experience as a key metric for success, recognising that how participants feel, connect, and grow during an event is just as important as what they learn.

In addition, more associations are seeking to leave a lasting, positive legacy in their host cities, measuring the impact of their meetings within their own communities and on society at large. That's the transformative power of associations and the meetings they convene.



INTERNATIONAL SOCIETY ON THROMBOSIS AND HAEMOSTASIS (ISTH)

The ISTH Congress —held annually, rotating internationally, and drawing between 4,000 and 9,000 attendees — is the organisation's flagship event. Beyond delivering scientific exchange and member connection, it provides essential financial support for ISTH's broader programmes.

"Our annual congress is consistently ranked as the most valued program by our members. It's central to our mission and our ability to deliver impactful work," said Thomas Reiser, Executive Director of ISTH.

ISTH is observing changes in how meetings are evolving. Attendees are registering later, becoming more selective, and facing the impact of geopolitics and rising costs on their decisions. Geopolitical uncertainty may make travel less enticing, but ISTH sees this as an even stronger reason to bring people together. At the same time, inflation, particularly for services such as AV and stand building, presents significant operational challenges.

Member engagement is central to ISTH's approach. Over 300 volunteers are involved in developing the scientific programme, ensuring broad participation and relevance across its international community.

When selecting host cities, ISTH looks beyond infrastructure. The organisation values destinations that are genuinely interested in the mission, offer guidance in navigating the local context, and act as trusted, unbiased partners, not only economic beneficiaries. ISTH evaluates its meetings based on the quality of scientific contributions, the satisfaction of attendees, and the financial outcomes that enable continued delivery of its mission.

Sustainability, while not guided by specific goals, remains a priority. ISTH aims to reduce waste and environmental impact wherever possible—limiting printed materials, avoiding single-use items, and favouring public transport over private transfers. Diversity, equity, and inclusion are also highly important. The organisation has clear Key Performance Indicators (KPIs) in place, particularly around representation in the invited programme.

Innovation is gradually being built into all aspects of congress development and management. While the process is slow, ISTH is focused on integrating tools that support human activity and increase productivity.

Looking ahead, ISTH aims to remain steady, agile, and incrementally innovative. It is also exploring the potential for more collaboration between meetings and organisations.

LEAVING A LASTING IMPACT VIENNA'S STRATEGIC APPROACH TO MEETING LEGACIES -A CASE STUDY ON ERS 2024

Vienna: A City Where Meetings Create Meaningful Legacies

Vienna has long been recognized as one of the world's leading meeting destinations, not only due to its infrastructure, accessibility, and cultural offerings, but also because of its forward-thinking approach to the long-term impact of events. By actively promoting the concept of "legacy" as part of its strategic initiatives, Vienna actively encourages associations to think beyond the immediate success of their meetings and to create positive, sustainable effects that benefit both society and the local community.

The Vienna Convention Bureau (VCB) acts as a partner in this process, offering strategic advice, facilitating connections between congress organizers and local stakeholders, and supporting initiatives that align with the city's broader goals. Legacy creation is explicitly anchored as a core element of the Vienna Tourist Board's Visitor Economy Strategy 2025, emphasizing the importance of meetings and events in contributing to the sustainable development of the city.

With a clear focus on fostering knowledge exchange, advancing innovation, and improving citizens' lives, Vienna increasingly emphasizes legacy creation as an important aspect of major congresses held in the city.

While Vienna is steadily expanding its efforts in this area, legacy initiatives are currently being developed and supported through action programs, consultation services, and tailored advice for event organizers. By working closely with associations, Vienna aims to strengthen its approach to legacy creation and contribute to meaningful outcomes for both the local community and the international associations it hosts.



European Respiratory Society (ERS) Congress 2024 – Raising Awareness for Lung Health in Vienna

An outstanding example of Vienna's legacy strategy in action is the European Respiratory Society (ERS) Congress 2024. Bringing together more than 20,000 respiratory professionals from around the globe, ERS 2024 was not only a scientific meeting of exceptional scale but also a catalyst for promoting health literacy.

Recognizing the opportunity to leave a legacy beyond the congress center, ERS and the European Lung Foundation (ELF) collaborated closely with the Vienna Convention Bureau and local health stakeholders to launch a comprehensive public health campaign named "Healthy Lungs for Life".

Key elements included:

• Public Awareness Campaign: Organized in partnership between the European Respiratory Society (ERS) and the European Lung Foundation (ELF), the "Healthy Lungs for Life" campaign aimed to raise public awareness of lung health and promote preventative measures against lung disease. The campaign was launched on the first day of the congress with an event in front of Vienna's Giant Ferris Wheel. The event offered complimentary lung function tests to the general public throughout the weekend, with over 500 tests carried out in two days.

• Educational Outreach: In collaboration with the Board of Education for Vienna and as part of an initiative led by the Vienna Convention Bureau, visits were made to three schools in Vienna. These visits aimed to educate younger generations about the importance of lung health. Pupils had the opportunity to test their lung function aboard a mobile testing unit installed in an American school bus, which was also used at the Giant Ferris Wheel event. Special educational materials developed as part of the legacy project were made available to schools for integration into their curricula.

• Active Lifestyle Promotion: More than 500 walkers and runners participated in the "Take the Active Option" event, completing either a 5-kilometer run, or a 2.5-kilometer walk to promote the importance of physical activity for lung health. All proceeds from the sold-out event registrations were donated to the "Healthy Lungs for Life" campaign.


The "Healthy Lungs for Life" campaign, launched around the ERS Congress 2024, successfully combined public engagement, education, and advocacy to promote lung health in Vienna. By collaborating with local institutions and raising awareness among diverse audiences, the project created tangible benefits for the city. It demonstrates how associations can achieve meaningful, lasting impact beyond their scientific communities.

Choosing Vienna means choosing a destination where the influence of a meeting can extend far beyond the conference walls, creating lasting value for both participants and the host city.

REGIONAL INSIGHTS

While the global picture tells one story, the regional view reveals the diversity. Each region reflects different stages of growth, unique challenges, and strategic priorities, but all share a commitment to advancing the power and impact of international association meetings.





AFRICA

The Business Events industry in Africa continues to evolve into a strategic pillar for economic development, regional integration, and international trade. This transformation is driven by Africa's cultural diversity, a youthful and increasingly skilled workforce, improving infrastructure, and growing appeal among global event stakeholders.

According to the 2024 ICCA Rankings, South Africa led all African countries with 98 recorded meetings, followed by Rwanda, Kenya, Uganda, and Tanzania. Cape Town is ranked as the continent's top city with 58 meetings, ahead of Kigali, Nairobi, Kampala, and Johannesburg, highlighting the continent's growing competitiveness in the global meetings landscape.

The African Business Events industry was valued at USD 13.2 billion in 2022 and is projected to grow at a compound annual growth rate of 6.4% through 2030. This expansion reflects national strategies for economic diversification, infrastructure investment, and increased collaboration with international organisers. Governments across the continent are placing greater emphasis on Business Events as a high-impact sector rather than a subcategory of tourism.

South Africa remains the most mature Africa Business Events market, with global connectivity and venues like the Cape Town International Convention Centre, Durban ICC, and Sandton Convention Centre in Johannesburg continuing to attract major international events.

Rwanda has emerged as a rising star, transforming Kigali into a world-class destination through deliberate government strategy and investment. Prestigious events like CHOGM 2022 and the FIFA Congress in 2023 have positioned the city as a major global player. The Rwanda Convention Bureau has been instrumental in this progress. The launch of the ICCASkills hub for Africa in Kigali in early 2025 further cements Rwanda's regional leadership.

Ethiopia, home to institutions like the African Union and UN Economic Commission for Africa, draws consistent international attention. Addis Ababa's newly added International Convention and Exhibition Center significantly enhances capacity for diplomatic and development-related meetings.

Other countries are making major moves, too. **Nigeria** is investing in venues such as the Eko Convention Centre, Calabar International Convention Centre and Enugu International Centre. **Senegal** is positioning Dakar as a West African hub with the Dakar Arena. **Kenya** continues to capitalise on its strategic location, robust airline access, and Nairobi's Kenyatta International Convention Centre

National convention bureaus such as the South African National Convention Bureau, Rwanda Convention Bureau, Ethiopia Convention Bureau, and Uganda Convention Bureau are shaping the future of the region's Business Events ecosystem through strategic alignment and international promotion.

High-growth sectors such as healthcare, tech, energy, and agriculture are driving event demand. Flagship events like Africa Health, the Mobile World Congress in Kigali, Africa Tech Summit in Nairobi, and Mining Indaba in Cape Town showcase how Business Events is becoming central to Africa's broader economic story.

The future of the Business Events industry in Africa looks promising and transformative, positioning the continent as a competitive and dynamic player in the global events ecosystem.

NORTH AMERICA

While some regions are experiencing rapid growth, North America remains a "value stock"—established, consistent, and dependable. In 2024, it hosted approximately 10% of all tracked international meetings, maintaining its position as a cornerstone in the global portfolio.

The United States retained its #1 position globally, **Canada** held firm at #10, and **Mexico** remained within the top 30.

Montréal once again led North American cities, ranking #28 globally and reinforcing its strength in techrelated meetings. "Our highly engaged scientific community dedicated to hosting meetings makes a huge difference in key economic sectors like Life Sciences, Engineering, AI, and clean technology," said Martine Laberge, Director of Sales, Business Events, Tourism Montréal.

Toronto, Mexico City, and **Washington, D.C.** each hosted over 47 international meetings, with Washington nearly doubling its 2023 count, a result credited to its strategic shift to bid development 5 to 8 years ago. **Miami** also posted notable growth. In Canada, destinations like **Halifax, Ottawa,** and **Quebec City** are steadily increasing their share, shifting a landscape once dominated by Montréal, Toronto, and Vancouver. Similarly, **Guadalajara** and **Monterrey** continue to rise in Mexico, diversifying the country's event portfolio.

INFRASTRUCTURE

Infrastructure investments across the region underscore long-term confidence. **Calgary's** \$500 million expansion of the BMO Centre has made it Western Canada's largest convention venue. Renovations in Las Vegas, Savannah, and Austin, along with potential developments in Victoria, further strengthen the region's capacity.

SUSTAINABILITY

Sustainability continues to be a growing focus, with Vancouver, Washington, D.C., Edmonton, and Montréal leading in green initiatives. The **Palais des congrès de Montréal** (Montréal's convention centre) is one of the first carbonneutral convention centres in North America.

Generational change is reshaping the industry. As Millennials step into leadership, the region is rethinking how it delivers impact and value, with a growing focus on purpose and connection. "I see these meetings in 2025 and beyond becoming **more human, more connected, and more purpose-driven**," said Paola Blancas, Directora Comerical, Cancun Center, Mexico.

These values are increasingly reflected in how destinations define their role. "Industry sectors of strength won't just be accepted as statements and data points, but **will be exemplified in communities** through international association legacy initiatives," said Morgan Da Rocha, Sales Director, Destination Toronto.

Jennifer Diggens, Director of Sales at Calgary TELUS Convention Centre, adds: "Now more than ever, the world needs **trusted spaces** for truth, connection, and progress... In an increasingly divided world, **associations are unifiers** – and our industry remains committed to supporting their impact."

As Cheng observes, "What defines North America's strength isn't just our established capacity in the market – it's our ability to reinvent the value proposition. Our members are embracing innovation, sustainability, and deeper engagement with knowledge sectors."

LATIN AMERICA AND THE CARIBBEAN

Latin America and the Caribbean (LAC) will host the ICCA World Congress in 2026 in Panama City, spotlighting a region that continues to shape the future of international association meetings.

Home to more than 600 million people across 17+ countries and 30+ major cities, the region spans diverse landscapes—from the Amazon to the Andes—and is rich in cultural, linguistic, and ecological diversity. This dynamic context fuels entrepreneurial spirit, scientific research, and creativity across sectors.

- In 2024, LAC represented a combined GDP of \$6 trillion, with 3% annual growth.
- The region attracted \$184 billion in foreign direct investment and \$2.7 billion in venture capital, supporting the rise of 45 unicorns.
- Technology led the way, accounting for 40% of all VC funding, followed by growth in renewable energy, biotechnology, and creative industries.

For over 15 years, strong public-private collaboration has enhanced infrastructure, expanded talent pipelines, and increased competitiveness. More than 25 fully equipped convention centres now serve both capital and non-capital cities, supported by modernised airports and growing international connectivity. New integrated events and trade fair districts like <u>Bogotá's Corferias District</u> and São Paulo's GL events-led <u>Distrito Anhembi</u> are boosting the investment for the meetings sector while reshaping the experience for global events. "This region has proven its ability to deliver in terms of know-how, infrastructure, creativity, agility, and collaboration," said Andrés Escandón, ICCA Senior Regional Director for Latin America and the Caribbean

Convention bureaus and economic development agencies are aligning to promote LAC as a growth platform for international events. Universities and research institutions are helping attract meetings tied to local strengths in science, health, sustainability, and education.

Innovation districts such as the <u>City of Knowledge</u> in Panama, Medellín's <u>Science and Tech Hub</u>, and São Paulo University's <u>Innovation District</u> show how meetings align with broader development goals.

SUSTAINABILITY

Sustainability and legacy also remain strong drivers. Costa Rica's Convention Center recently launched its Carbon Clear Events methodology by Grupo Heroica, enabling carbon-neutral operations. Panama became the first Latin American country to establish a Global Association Hub, welcoming associations seeking regional presence and growth.

FIEXPO Latin America continues to serve as a cornerstone for the regional industry, consolidating each year as the main sector platform. Meanwhile, global and regional congresses hosted by IEEE, PANLAR, WFNS, and others have reinforced the region's capability and global recognition. Corporate events like Web Summit and Ethereum's Devcon, along with global government meetings including COP16 in Cali, Colombia, highlight LAC's growing appeal across sectors.

In 2024, Latin America and the Caribbean was one of the only two regions that grew in association meetings compared to 2023 (from 877 to 903).

Brazil retained its top country position, hosting over 230 meetings, and consolidating its position in the top 15 global country ranking.

Argentina and Colombia follow in the 2nd and 3rd positions regionally. At the city level, **Buenos Aires** continues to lead the Americas ranking, and 6 other regional cities are also part of the top 10 in the Americas: Santiago de Chile, Rio de Janeiro, Panama City, Bogota, Lima and São Paulo.

From the top 20 cities in the region, 75% grew in number of meetings from 2023 and 2024, acknowledging **Foz Do Iguaçu, Antigua, Santo Domingo**, and **Barranquilla** as the cities with the most significant growth rate.

Rio de Janeiro reaffirms its position as the main non-capital city in the region for international association meetings.

Ultimately, LAC's competitive advantage stems from its diverse destinations, unique infrastructure, skilled young population, and emerging sectors. Latin America and the Caribbean invite international associations to develop and enhance their missions, membership, and value through innovative meetings and collaboration.

COLOMBIA A MULTI-DESTINATION PORTFOLIO FOR INTERNATIONAL CONGRESSES AND CONVENTIONS

Colombia is crafting a new narrative in the global events industry—one that moves beyond traditional destination marketing and reimagines how a country positions itself for international meetings and conventions.

At the center of this transformation is ProColombia, the national agency for promoting responsible foreign investment, exports, and tourism. Its integrated organizational model allows for seamless alignment across these pillars, creating powerful synergies between tourism promotion, investment attraction. bidding. and event This vertically integrated approach sets Colombia apart the meetings industry, where in international events are no longer treated in isolation, but as strategic drivers of talent attraction, territorial exports. development, and sectoral positioning. Within ProColombia, business events have a dedicated team that connects global opportunities with the country's economic priorities.

A core element of the strategy is leveraging Colombia's regional diversity. By working closely with emerging city ProColombia has destinations, strengthened the national value chain for meetings and events, generating business opportunities far beyond the traditional hubs. Cities such as Mompox, Valledupar, Santa Marta, Barranguilla, Cali, Pereira, and Armenia—each with distinct industry clusters, innovation ecosystems, and cultural assets—are now positioned Bogotá, alongside Cartagena, and Medellín to form a multi-destination portfolio that caters to a wide range of international associations and congresses.

In partnership with ICCA, ProColombia has executed several tactical initiatives to boost national competitiveness. These include a nationwide business events roadshow across the seven emerging cities, and Colombia's role as the first country to host ICCA's Destination Enhancement Programme, designed to upskill the eleven convention bureaus that form the country's National Network of Bureaux.

The results are already evident. Colombia has consolidated its third-place ranking in the ICCA Latin America Country Ranking 2024, with significant growth over the previous year. This progress is not only a reflection of strong performance in mature destinations, but also a direct result of regional cities gaining ground in the global events landscape.

By showcasing its regional assets and sectoral strengths, ProColombia has enhanced its global marketing efforts with a broader, more inclusive product offering —one that resonates with international organizers seeking authentic, high-impact destinations.

Colombia's model demonstrates that when event attraction is embedded in a national development strategy, the returns are exponential—not only for destinations, but for associations, meeting planners, and communities alike.

SUSTAINABILITY AS A COMPETITIVE ADVANTAGE

Sustainability has become a key priority on the global meetings industry agenda. Initiatives such as Net Zero Carbon Events (NZCE) and the Bangkok Protocol for Sustainable Gastronomy reflect the sector's growing commitment—led in part by ICCA—to advancing sustainable practices.

Costa Rica has long stood at the forefront of global sustainability efforts, known for its unique convergence of nature, tourism, and climate action. The country's Tourism Sustainability Policy and the creation of the Sustainable Tourism Certificate (CST) serve as international benchmarks for best practices in sustainable tourism.

When the Costa Rica Convention Center (CCCR) opened in 2018, expectations were high for a venue that could set a new standard in sustainable events. Owned by the Costa Rica Tourism Board (ICT) and operated by Grupo Heroica, a regional venue management company, the CRCC took a bold step forward in 2023 with the launch of Carbon Clear Events by Heroica —a proprietary methodology designed to achieve full carbon-neutral operations.

The journey toward a carbon-neutral convention center included:

- In-depth analysis of historical venue data
- Installation of an advanced waste
 management system
- On-site water treatment facilities
- Adoption of sustainable gastronomy policies
- Installation of solar panels and an autonomous electricity system
- Sourcing from local communities to strengthen regional value chains
- Implementation of a sustainability-first organizational culture
- Forthcoming addition of a MEGAPACK auxiliary power system to optimize energy distribution
- Carbon offsetting via Costa Rica's MICE Forest, a joint initiative by ICT and FONAFIFO
- Certification by LSQA and validation by the Costa Rican Climate Change Office

Together, these initiatives form a pioneering decarbonization framework, where mitigation takes precedence over compensation.

For the CCCR and its stakeholders, sustainability is not just a responsibility it's a strategic choice. Rooted in the national ethos of Costa Rica, it strengthens the venue's positioning as an appealing destination for international associations and companies seeking conscious, futureready infrastructure.

It's encouraging to witness a significant rise in association meetings in the Asia Pacific region, as countries / territories like China, Hong Kong, Indonesia, Japan, Macau and Sri Lanka have all shown growth relative to previous years. At the city level, Singapore ranked 3rd globally, while Japan maintained its position among the top 10 countries worldwide.

While rankings tell part of the story, association bidding involves multiple factors. Destinations across the region offer authentic, strategic solutions that create a profound impact on destination development, enhance collaboration across various sectors and ministries, and benefit host communities. In addition, destinations understand that association biddings secure future business, and this year's rankings highlight the growth of many emerging cities in the Asia Pacific, one of the world's fastest-developing regions.

It has been a defining year for ICCA's Asia Pacific Chapter, marked by first-time achievements and new initiatives that reflect the determination to lead meaningful change. This evolution aligns with ICCA's broader commitment to measuring success beyond economic impact, emphasising sustainability, social value, the development of young professionals, and innovation that leaves a legacy for communities.



With the support of BESarawak, the first Association Impact Masterclass was launched in Kuching, Sarawak, in April 2024. Designed to strengthen associations' understanding of impact and effectiveness, the programme will roll out to other regions as part of a global effort to elevate the leadership and collaboration of cross-sectoral associations.

Asia Pacific's venue members actively shape the region's business events landscape, contributing to innovation, sustainability, wellness, and DEI best practices. They serve as one-stop partners, creating memorable attendee

experiences to boost destination profiles. This momentum led to the first <u>ICCA Global Experts Forum</u> in Beijing, which brought together venue leaders, investors, and government stakeholders to explore the evolving role of venues in future-ready growth alongside destinations.

KNOWLEDGE

Across the region, we observed a growing desire toward more purposeful programming and engagement. The destinations that understand the real value of the meetings and events industry will be the ones able to forge a more sustainable growth for their societies.

ICCAUni, ICCA's education-focussed initiative connecting members with academic insitutions across Asia Pacific to support research and talent development, is at the forefront of driving engagement with the next generation of events professionals.

SUSTAINABILITY

At the 2024 ICCA Congress in Abu Dhabi, we implemented the 2023 Congress legacy initiative, which was supported by the Thailand Convention and Exhibition Bureau. The 2024 Congress earned the <u>PLEDGE</u> on Food Waste's Zero Food Waste to Landfill Event Certification, marking a key milestone in the Bangkok Protocol on Sustainable Gastronomy. ICCA is dedicated to leading sustainable food and beverage (F&B) planning, providing tools and case studies to inspire the industry to enhance sustainable practices and offering cultural authenticity.

GENERATIONAL CHANGE

Professional development is a regional priority. In 2024, two in-person Certified International Convention Specialist (CICS) programmes were held in Beijing, one in Macao. The Certified International Convention Executive (CICE) programme was also launched in Christchurch, New Zealand. With more than 60 colleagues earning their designations, their enhanced knowledge and readiness reflect our members' commitment to investing in human capital, thereby strengthening the region's overall future readiness and business success.

The ongoing success of the <u>Asia Pacific Business Events Youth Challenges</u> spotlighted innovative ideas from university students and professionals under 30, as the 2024 event was held in Daejeon, the Republic of Korea. Additionally, the CIMERT programme marked its fifth anniversary—a significant milestone in its journey. Looking ahead, ICCA and the Chengdu government will continue to deepen their collaboration, enhancing industry capacity to foster business innovation and drive meaningful community development.

Europe maintained its leading position in the 2024 ICCA Rankings, topping the charts in both meeting volume and member destinations. But in a rapidly shifting landscape, leadership is no longer just about scale. It's about agility, innovation, and long-term alignment.

Vienna topped the global city rankings in 2024, recognised for its meeting volume and long-term vision. **Lisbon** followed closely, just one meeting behind.

Capital cities and major hubs such as **London, Paris**, and **Amsterdam** continue to rank highly. Still, associations are increasingly turning to second- and third-tier destinations that offer flexibility, accessibility, and stronger local alignment. **Porto's** selection as host of the 2024 ICCA Congress reflects this shift, highlighting how smaller cities that think strategically and invest in sustainable competitiveness are rising on the global stage.

Italy, ranked #2 globally among countries, also exemplifies this trend through a national strategy that empowers regional destinations via coordinated investment and collaboration.

While operational challenges persist, European cities are adapting. The Paris Olympic Games and major political summits in 2024 created temporary constraints, while broader geopolitical and economic shifts shaped site selection across the continent.

A major policy milestone was the EU's appointment of <u>Apostolos Tzitzikostas as Commissioner for Tourism</u> and <u>Infrastructure</u>, reflecting growing recognition of the sector's strategic role in sustainable development, regional cohesion, and innovation.

DIGITALISATION

Digital transformation is reshaping events across Europe. Artificial intelligence is now central to content planning, delegate engagement, knowledge capture, and even bid writing. Events like IMEX Frankfurt, IBTM World in Barcelona, the Association Leadership Forum at The Meetings Show in London, and the European Association Summit in Brussels are driving this evolution.

SUSTAINABILITY

Sustainability also remains a core priority. The Nordic region, particularly Copenhagen and Helsinki, continues to lead in environmental standards, with meetings focused on public health, circular economy, smart cities, and clean energy. Türkiye became the first country to sign a national-level agreement with the GSTC, launching a mandatory program to accelerate sustainable practices across its tourism sector.

KNOWLEDGE

Knowledge alignment is a defining strength. In the Netherlands, Leiden is recognised as a European City of Science. Leuven in Belgium has emerged as a robotics and healthcare hub, thanks to Katholieke Universiteit Leuven. Edinburgh draws on the University of Edinburgh's AI and digital health expertise. In France, Lyon has become a centre for oncology and infectious diseases, supported by IARC and Bioaster. Paris continues to host events tied to Sorbonne University and its global leadership in AI ethics, digital health, and mobility.



PARTNERSHIP & COLLABORATION

National initiatives are gaining traction. Italy's Knowledge Leaders programme connects academia with international bids. Barcelona's legacy programmes are designed to align international conferences with the city's strategic priorities, fostering long-term impact through collaboration with local stakeholders and communities. Germany's Future Meeting Space initiative, led by the German Convention Bureau and Fraunhofer Institute, explores next-generation knowledge transfer formats.

GENERATIONAL CHANGE

Professional development is advancing through ICCA's CICS and CICE certifications. The ICCA Skills Hub in Luxembourg offers a dedicated space for training, helping strengthen local teams and grow a future-ready workforce.

2024 marked a turning point in the region's business events narrative. The United Arab Emirates, Qatar, Saudi Arabia, Bahrain, Oman, and Jordan demonstrated a collective commitment to investing in knowledge economies, tourism infrastructure, and sector-driven meeting strategies. From public-private partnerships to long-term national Business Events plans, the role of government in attracting international association meetings has never been more visible.

Destinations are increasingly aligned with national development goals such as Saudi Arabia's Vision 2030 and the UAE's Economic D33 Agenda. A noticeable shift from event-hosting to legacy-building and impact-driven agendas continues to take hold.

The region's ability to secure and deliver major events remained strong in 2024.

Dubai, the top-ranked city in the region, secured the World Congress of Anaesthesiologists 2028, which is set to welcome over 10,000 delegates.

Qatar won the FIDIC Global Infrastructure Conference, reinforcing its role in engineering and innovation

Riyadh was awarded the World Road Congress 2026.

Meanwhile, **Abu Dhabi** expanded its portfolio of high-impact events, successfully bidding to host the IUCN World Conservation Congress in 2025—expected to attract over 15,000 global delegates—underscoring its commitment to sustainability and long-term environmental legacies.

These wins reflect a sharpened approach to bidding: data-led, ambassador-driven, and closely aligned with publicsector vision and global priorities.

As we reflect on the 2024 ICCA Rankings, one thing is clear: international association meetings are not merely recovering — it is evolving with purpose, innovation, and strategic intent.

NAVIGATING TOMORROW'S LANDSCAPE

Looking ahead, our industry will continue to reshape how international association meetings are conceived, designed, and delivered. Several trends are already guiding this transformation.

First, we're seeing a growing emphasis on **knowledge-driven partnerships**. Destinations are moving beyond showcasing infrastructure to demonstrating knowledge alignment, innovation ecosystems, and academic excellence. This shift creates more meaningful collaborations among destinations, associations, and local stakeholders - partnerships built not just on logistics but also on shared purpose and expertise.

Decentralisation and new players are reshaping the map. Emerging destinations are rising, reflecting a broadening of opportunities across the world. Associations are increasingly exploring alternatives to traditional host cities, seeking better value, authentic experiences, and stronger alignment with their objectives. This trend will continue to decentralise international meetings, creating space for new destinations to establish themselves on the global map.

Sustainability as a strategy is no longer optional. Environmental responsibility has evolved from a nice-to-have feature to a critical component of meeting design and destination strategy. Forward-thinking destinations are embedding sustainability into their core operations, infrastructure development, and legacy planning, and turning it into their unique value proposition in a competitive global market.

Finally, **shifting association needs** are creating new experiences. Associations themselves are evolving, with new leadership, changing member expectations, and evolving business models. The most successful destinations will be those that understand these shifts and position themselves as partners in helping associations achieve their broader missions, not just as venues for their events.

ADDRESSING EMERGING CHALLENGES

While opportunities abound, the industry also faces challenges that require collective attention and innovative responses.

Economic pressures are top of mind. Rising operational costs, inflationary pressures, and budget constraints are impacting how associations plan and fund their meetings. METHODOLOGY

The annual ICCA Statistics Report contains aggregated association meetings data from ICCA's Business Intelligence database. Association meetings are only included if they:

- Take place on a regular basis
- Rotate among a minimum of three countries/territories
- Have at least 50 participants

DATA COLLECTION

At the end of every year, ICCA's Data Research department will send out a call to all its members to submit meeting data for their destination for that particular year. The deadline is 1st February of the following year. Meeting data will be processed within approximately three months.

SNAPSHOT

After the data has been processed, an annual snapshot will be generated. Based on this snapshot, the static annual statistics report will be created and published within a month, alongside ICCA's Business Analytics (BA), which is an online benchmark tool for destinations. Readers should note that this report is a "snapshot" of qualifying meetings from ICCA's Business Intelligence database as sampled on April 24th 2025, and that future statistics may be amended as ICCA becomes aware of additional meeting data.

PARTICIPANT NUMBERS

If a meeting for a specific year does not have a participant number, an estimated average participant number will be used instead, based on known historical participant numbers for that meeting.

EXPENDITURE FACTOR

To calculate the estimated total expenditure, ICCA applies an Expenditure Factor, which is set at 0.22 (or 22%). This number was established based on two historical expenditure studies performed by Vienna and Finland CVB. The results of these studies showed that approximately 22% of the total expenditure of one delegate was spent on the registration fee. The other 78% of the total expenditure was spent on travel, accommodation, gastronomy, public transport, culture/leisure, shopping and telecommunication.

In 2019, ICCA performed a similar expenditure study during its annual international congress in Houston. This study showed that 25% of the total expenditure per delegate was spent on the registration fee. As this percentage is close to 22%, we decided to maintain 22% for future reports as well. ICCA plans to do periodic corroborative expenditure studies during its congress to ensure the reliability of the Expenditure Factor to ensure reliable Expenditure Factor.

CALCULATING THE ESTIMATED TOTAL EXPENDITURE FOR 2024

As ICCA's Research Department collects the registration fee per meeting, where possible, it is able to calculate the estimated total expenditure per delegate per meeting. This is done by dividing the registration fee by 0,22.

In order to get the estimated total expenditure per meeting (i.e. for one whole meeting), we multiply it by the total number of delegates for that meeting.

For 2024, ICCA has identified 11,099 meetings in total, with an average registration fee of USD564 and an average delegate number of 409.

To calculate the estimated total expenditure for all 2024 meetings, we apply the following formula:

(Avg. Registration Fee all meetings/0,22) x Avg. #delegates all meetings X Total #meetings = (564/0,22) x 409 x 11.099 = 11,6B USD

Note: all registration fees in ICCA statistical reports are converted to US Dollars.
